## Steps for Enrollment

1. Cut out this page.
2. Complete the Registration Form and Deposit Calculation Form.
3. Return completed forms with \$100 deposit/child/session. **Do not procrastinate, as spaces are limited.**
4. Spaces will be filled in the order that we receive enrollment forms with deposits. Priority enrollment for previously enrolled campers ends on April 8.
5. Brochures are mailed out a month earlier to all previously enrolled campers, then mailed out to the general public.
6. Southside limits its enrollment to only 40 campers and 4 Junior Helpers.
7. All new families will be required to complete additional paper-work.

Enrollment is on a first come/first served basis. Please refer to the information below for choices of sessions. **To secure enrollment please return the completed registration form with a \$100 deposit per session, per child for each session chosen.** The difference is due on the first Monday of the session in which your children attend. The \$100 deposit towards the tuition payment is nonrefundable. All session fees must be paid in advance on the first Monday of each session. No child will be admitted into camp without full payment of session received at time of drop-off.

## Camp Southside Policies

1. All campers are required to be at Southside by 8:30 a.m. in order to participate in daily field trips.
2. Swimsuits shall NOT be worn under clothing as underwear. Please send you child's labeled swimsuit and towel in a bag.
3. Southside is not responsible for lost items. Please leave valuables at home.
4. Campers and Junior Helpers are required to wear their camp T-shirts for field trips. Please check the Southside calendar for when your child should wear his/her t-shirt.
5. Campers will be going on several field trips each week. All children will be transported in a Southside van and are required to wear seatbelts. Drivers of the Southside van have passed the Louisiana "Class D" Commercial Driver's License test, carry mobile phones and have clean driving records.
6. When dropping-off children in the morning, please use our valet service. In the afternoon, park your car in the side parking lot and come inside to pick-up and sign-out your child.
7. In order to insure that all campers have a safe and fun-filled summer, Southside has implemented a set of discipline rules that all campers must follow.

### DISCIPLINE POLICY:

- A. Respect and listen to all counselors and Junior Helpers.
- B. Be quiet when walking past the other classrooms.
- C. Walk when inside the building.
- D. Respect the rights of fellow campers and younger children at Southside.
- E. Respect any equipment you are allowed to use, and return it to it's proper place when finished with it.

### CONSEQUENCES:

- A. Verbal warning from counselor.
- B. Removal from activity (time-out).
- C. Parents called to discuss problems.
- D. Conference with Director
- E. Expulsion if problems cont.
